(10 consecutive business days)

9:00 am – 2:00 pm each day and Thursday, October 14th till 7 pm

<u>AGE</u>	Applicant must be at least 18 years of age.
<u>EDUCATION</u>	Must have a High School Diploma or GED (General Educational Diploma) or TASC (Test Assessing Secondary Completion) or Equivalent. Transcripts are required upon selection.
<u>DRIVER'S LICENSE REQUIREMENTS</u>	To receive an application you must have a valid NYS CDL – A or B Driver's License with Air Brakes . You must have taken your Road Test on a Truck with a Standard Shift Transmission and Air Brakes. Reliable means of transportation is necessary.
<u>PHYSICAL & DRUG/ALCOHOL TEST</u>	Must be able to pass a DOT Physical to be medically cleared to operate Heavy Equipment and drive Trucks and Cranes. You must be able to pass pre-employment and random Drug/Alcohol tests in accordance with DOT standards.
<u>RESIDENCE</u>	Must be a resident of either Erie, Wyoming, Cattaraugus, Chautauqua, Orleans, Niagara, or the western part of Genesee County, (Excluding the city of Batavia).
<u>CITIZENSHIP</u>	Must be a citizen of the U.S.A. or legally entitled to work here.
<u>TRAINING PERIOD</u>	Program is 4 years with a minimum of 5000 hours.
<u>PAY</u>	While on the Job you will be paid by the Contractor. If eligible, you may collect Unemployment or Veteran's benefits while at the Training Site.
<u>APPLICATIONS</u>	For the Class starting in April 2022 : May be obtained <u>IN PERSON</u> at the <u>TRAINING CENTER ONLY</u> . Must be returned within 10 business days.
